


Originally built by William Ledyard and Moses Aldrich in 1874, the Ledyard Building is a historic address that is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Today, the building stands as the second-oldest, commercial building operating in Grand Rapids.

After acquiring the building in 2012, CWD added significant mechanical, technological improvements to the building, and expansion of collaborative common areas, dramatically enhancing the amenities offered to all tenants. These improvements were completed with the highest quality materials that are consistent with the irreplaceable historic details of the building.

Located at 125 Ottawa Ave NW, the building overlooks Rosa Parks Circle at the epicenter of the City's business and entertainment districts. Its close proximity to the City's finest selection of hotels, restaurants, and night life makes the Ledyard Building a popular destination for visitors and locals alike. The building's co-tenancy includes dining options like Uccello's Ristorante, as well as retail spaces like Wimee's Words, Periwinkle Fog, Superior Watch Repair, and more.


## TOTAL SQUARE FEET
